March brings our second set of report cards and opportunity for parents to come and be part of our Celebrations of Learning. Progress report cards for Preschool will be sent home March 15th and 16th. K-6 report cards will go live via the Parent Portal in Power-School on March 17th at 12:00 p.m. If you need support in logging in to your account, please let us know. The process for accessing report cards remains the same as last term.

We are excited that our Celebrations of Learning on March 22<sup>nd</sup> (4:00-7:00) and 23rd (3:30-6:30) will be in-person and student led. As is typical for our in-person Celebrations of Learning, there will be an additional student and their family in the room with your family during your visit. If you would like to book an appointment to speak to your child's teacher one on one or are more comfortable receiving a phone call instead of an in-person Celebration of Learning, please let your child's teacher know. It is important to our school that our parents are informed about student progress and development. Please join with us in celebrating the excellent learning your child is doing at our school. Information regarding signing up for Celebration of Learning will be coming home next week. Our spring Book Fair will also occur in-person during Celebration of Learn-



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# Lower Elementary, Gr. 1, 2, 3

Hello, Parkside families!

February passed quickly with all of our events and fun themed days. We celebrated Community Kindness Week, our Identity Fair, the 100th day of school and Pink Shirt Day. In addition, Teachers have been collecting data from this great term of learning. There has been incredible growth this term, both academically and socially. Report Cards will be available online March 17th and our Celebration of Learning is taking place March 22nd & 23rd. Please keep your eyes out from your child's teacher with more information regarding our Celebration of Learning.

Starting in March and for the remainder of the year, Grade 1's will be working towards fluently adding and subtracting to 20, Grade 2's to 100 and Grade 3's to 1000, in addition to our investigation of measurement, money and time.

In Science, we will be using the following questions to guide our learning in Science: How do plants and animals survive? and What is investigation?

In Language Arts, we have been practicing sequencing and summarizing stories read to us. In March, we will continue this learning by creating our own stories.

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# Upper Elementary, Gr. 4, 5, 6

Greetings from Upper ELMO!

February was a very short but very busy month. Our students were thoroughly engaged in exploring aspects of their identities and the value of diversity through their work for the whole-school Identity Fair and Community Kindness Week projects. Our students have proved themselves to be great leaders with many taking on classroom or whole school roles including patrolling and leading or helping to coach clubs for younger students.

March is a time when we are very busy assessing student learning. Students are completing many different assignments and projects and are preparing for their Celebrations of Learning mid-month.

In Math we have been working on Algebra and Order of Operations. Students have been working on balancing equations and preservation off equality. We have enjoyed creating and solving equations that have one of more variables. In March we will shift our focus from Number to Geometry, exploring many concepts including symmetry and tessellations.

In Language students continue to loop through many different concepts in their writing. Our kindness focus in February led to a natural exploration of letter writing and thank you cards. Students have expressed a great interest in narrative writing and are now working on using a plan then following with a checklist to edit their work. Everyone continues to practice grammar and word study in class using their Montessori materials.

In Science our grade 5 students have been learning all about weather, clouds and temperature. Grade 6 students have been learning about matter and energy. They enjoyed creating their own thermometers and discussing the limits of homemade technology. Grade 4 students have been learning about light and shadows.

In Social Studies our grade 5s are putting the finishing touches on their personal "History of Canada" mini book libraries- keep an eye out for them at our upcoming Celebration of Learning. Grade 6 students continue learn about the Iroquois Confederacy and have been discussing the ideas of democracy and consensus. Our Grade 4s continue their work of learning about Alberta and are beginning

to take a deeper look at our history, First Nations, settlers and important people who helped make Alberta what it is today.

We have all been practicing recorders students have been eager to learn many different songs such as "Mary had a little lamb", "Hot Cross Buns", and "Happy Birthday". Art students have been creating yarn/thread art. Many are cross-stitching, making small animals, and yarn landscapes. Once these projects are complete, we will move onto making sculptures.
